- 10mm, 15mm (deep) Socket
- #5 Allen Bit
- Trim Clip Tool
- WD-40 (Optional)
- Flathead Screwdriver/Small Pry Bar

#### SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate
- -1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

# TIME REQUIRED

-2 Hours

Time to install this should only take about two hours.

STEP 1 Peel back the paper from the heat shield and install it onto the back of the mount.

STEP 3 | Use a trim clip tool to remove the plastic covers from the tiedown hooks.

The number of tie-downs varies on trim of vehicle.





STEP 4 Use a 10mm socket to remove the hardware securing the factory tie-downs to the vehicle.








STEP 5 | Lift and fold the carpet forward to access the hardware securing the factory storage box to the vehicle.



STEP 6 Use a 10mm socket to remove the hardware securing the factory storage box to the vehicle.











STEP 7 Use a 15mm deep socket to loosen the clamp securing the muffler to the exhaust tube.

Note: Skip to Step 12 if installing on Bronco Raptor.







STEP 8 | Remove the muffler from the exhaust hangers.

One is located next to the hitch, and the other is located between the muffler and driver side rear tire.

These may require some force to remove. Use WD-40 and a pry tool if necessary.












STEP 9 | Remove the muffler by pulling it from the exhaust tube towards the rear of the vehicle.





STEP 10 Use a 10mm socket and a trim clip tool to remove the factory hardware and plastic clip retainers securing the factory heat shield in place.

Then remove the factory heat shield.








STEP 11 | Loosely secure the mounting plate using the factory hardware.



STEP 12 | Place the DV8 storage box under the vehicle and lift it to the mounting plate by reaching down through the empty space in the cab.

Loosely secure the box to the mounting plate using the provided M8 hardware.

Note: This step is easier with assistance.



STEP 13 | Secure using the provided M8 hardware and a #5 allen bit.







STEP 14 | Use a 10mm socket to install the mounting plate using the factory hardware.



Note: Skip to Step 18 if installing on Bronco Raptor



STEP 16 | Finish securing the muffler by re-installing it onto the hangers.









STEP 17 | Secure the clamp on the exhaust using a 15mm deep socket.



STEP 18 | Install factory tie-downs using a 10mm socket and the factory hardware.





 $\begin{array}{c|c} \text{STEP 19} & \text{Install the factory tie-down} \\ \text{covers by pressing them into place.} \end{array}$ 

Then flip the carpet closed.









STEP 20 | Congratulations! You are finished with the install of the 21+ Ford Bronco Storage Compartment.
