


TOOLS REQUIRED

- T-50 Torque head socket
- #4, #5 Allen Tool
- 10mm wrench
- Safety Glasses

SKILL LEVEL

- Novice/Intermediate
- -1 (you) to 2 persons

Little skill level required, you can easily install it by yourself however, additional help will be useful

TIME REQUIRED

-1.5 Hours

Time to install this should only take about an hour and a half


Begin by unpacking all items and inspecting for missing pieces or damage. If you have any concerns, please contact the company the product was purchased from. Extra hardware may be included with the product.


(8) M6x20 Bolts

(2) M8 Flat Washer

- (6) M6 Nylock Nuts
- (4) M6x14 Bolts
- (2) M8x30 Bolts



STEP 1 | Remove the seat belts mounting bolt cover by pulling down on top and away from seat belt. Use a T50 Torx tool to remove the seat belt mounting bolt





STEP 2 | Using the T50, remove the (3) bolts shown holding the hardtop to the cab.







STEP 3 | Using the factory hardware, loosely install the rear bracket onto the hardtop mount.

Note the orientation to ensure you have the correct bracket.



STEP 4 | Loosely Install the forward bracket on the hardtop mount using a T50 torx bit and the factory hardware.

Note the orientation to ensure you have the correct bracket.



STEP 5 | Lastly, using a #5 allen head and the provided M8 bolt, loosely install the roll bar bracket onto the vehicle.

Note the orientation to ensure you have the correct bracket.









STEP 6 | Moving to the molle panel, install the lower rear bracket onto the panel until secure using the M6 hardware provided a 10mm socket and #4 allen.

Note the orientation to ensure you have the correct bracket. (Shown in image is the passenger side).










STEP 7 | Once the lower bracket is installed, position the molle panel into the vehicle against the previously installed brackets.

To hold the molle panel up, using the seat belt bolt, loosely install into place.










STEP 8 Using the provided M6 hardware, #4 allen and 10mm wrench or socket, attach panel to the mounts placed in the prior steps.












STEP 9 | Once panel is mounted, align and center panel to ensure it is not rubbing on any of the plastic or painted surfaces.

Holding in place, secure all hardware and mounts.

Re-tighten seat belt bolt.



STEP 10 \mid Replace seat belt cover.



STEP 11 | Double check panel is tight and all hardware is secure.
