

- (2) M12 Nylon Lock Nut




STEP 2 | Use an 18mm socket to remove the factory bolt securing the strut in place.



STEP $1 \mid$ Slide the skid plate over the lower strut mount, and loosely secure the factory shock bolt and the provided M8 hardware.

Recommended: Use a small amount of thread locker on this bolt.










STEP 4 Use a 17mm socket and 19mm wrench to secure the provided M10 hardware.

Repeat steps for opposite side of the vehicle.
